Interview Resource for Higher-Level Professionals

WHY <u>THIS</u> COMPANY, <u>THIS</u> ROLE? For Higher-Level Professionals

This worksheet is intended to help you articulate a compelling and genuine answer to this common and important interview question.

1. DEEP DIVE INTO THE COMPANY

- Mission & Values: What does this company stand for? How do their values resonate with yours?
- Recent News & Initiatives: What are they doing that excites you? Any new products, projects, or expansions?
- Culture & Leadership: What is their work environment like? What is their leadership style? (Research on LinkedIn, Glassdoor, company website)
- **Industry Standing:** Where do they fit in the market? What are their competitive advantages? What are the challenges they face?

• Challenges: What are the potential challenges of this role, and how are you equipped to handle them?

3. CONNECT THE DOTS:

• Personal Alignment: Why are you personally drawn to this company and this role? What unique value can YOU bring?

WHY THIS COMPANY, THIS ROLE?

3. CONNECT THE DOTS (CONT):

• Career Goals: How does this position fit into your long-term career aspirations?

• Enthusiasm & Passion: What specifically excites you about this opportunity?

4. CRAFT YOUR RESPONSE:

- **Be Specific**: Avoid generic statements. Use your research to demonstrate a genuine understanding of the company and the role.
- Show Enthusiasm: Let your passion shine through!
- **Highlight Your Value:** Connect your skills and experience to the role's requirements.
- Focus on the Future: Express your eagerness to contribute to the company's success.

Remember: Authenticity is key. The best answer is one that truly reflects your interests and motivations.

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Examples of Compelling Answers for Executive Job Seekers

EXAMPLE 1: FOCUS ON IMPACT

"I've been following [Company Name]'s work in [Company's area of impact] for several years now, and I'm consistently impressed by your commitment to [Specific company value or initiative]. In my previous role at [Previous company], I led a project that [Describe a project that aligns with the company's values], and the results were incredibly rewarding. EXAMPLE 2: FOCUS ON GROWTH AND INNOVATION
